**A RESOLUTION** approving the settlement of the claims of Ramona Shoup in the case styled Ramona Shoup v. Jackson County, Missouri, No. 2116-CV03434, now pending in the Circuit Court of Jackson County, Missouri, for a total payment by the County of \$36,000.00.

WHEREAS, Ramona Shoup has filed a lawsuit styled Ramona Shoup v. Jackson County, Missouri, No. 2116-CV03434, now pending in the Circuit Court of Jackson County, Missouri, seeking damages for an alleged slip-and-fall injury suffered in the visitation lobby of the Historic Truman Courthouse in Independence; and,

WHEREAS, after a thorough investigation and negotiations, the County Counselor recommends a settlement in the amount of \$36,000.00, to be paid by the County to Ramona Shoup and/or her attorney, Peter Goss; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed settlement will limit the County's financial obligation in this matter and is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Counselor be and hereby is authorized to settle the claims of Ramona Shoup by the total payment of \$36,000.00, in full, final, and complete release of all of the claims against the County and all of its employees, officers, agents, and servants, as to any

damages incurred; and,


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Counselor be and hereby is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effect this settlement; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to issue a check or checks in an amount totaling \$36,000.00 in full and complete settlement of this claim, payable to Ramona Shoup and/or her attorney Peter Goss d/b/a The Goss Law Firm PC, pursuant to the specific direction of the County Counselor.
