
WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Legal Counsel has entered into a Legal Services Agreement dated May 22, 2019, whereunder Legal Counsel agreed to provide specialized legal advice, assistance, and representation to the County relating to an employment lawsuit styled *Doug Caster v. Jackson County, Missouri, et al*, Case Number 1616-CV23856, and;

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to increase the maximum sum available for services rendered under this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, County and Legal Counsel respectively promise, covenant and agree with each other as follows:

- 1. Except as expressly provided herein, all provisions of the Legal Services Agreement dated May 22, 2019, and the previous addendum, between Legal Counsel and County shall remain in full force and effect.
- 2. The maximum sum to be paid by County to Legal Counsel shall be increased by the amount of \$356,500.00 for a new maximum total of \$725,550.00.
- 3. The Fifth Addendum shall be effective as of January 1, 2022, and shall remain in effect,



together with the Prior Agreement, and all previous addendums, until December 31, 2022.

4. This Fifth Addendum to Agreement together with the Prior Agreement, and the previous addendums, incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.
