Project/Title:

A RESOLUTION authorizing the County Executive to execute a First Amendment To a Cooperative Agreement to Restore the Jackson County Longview Trail Impacted by Replacement of Raytown Road Double-Pipe Culverts with the City of Grandview, Missouri, for construction services, at an actual cost to the County in the amount of \$118,262.00.

Request Summary

Jackson County and the City of Grandview entered into a Cooperative Agreement dated July 8, 2022 to cover the County's share of costs for the design and engineering of a bicycle and pedestrian bridge along the Longview Trail, and adjacent to Raytown Road, within the City of Grandview as a part of the City's planned improvements to Raytown Road. The project includes removal of an existing double-pipe culvert underneath the road and trail and the construction of replacement infrastructure to rebuild the roadway and trail. The City applied for and received \$1,700,000 in Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Funds for the project through the Missouri Department of Transportation.

Grandview has bid the project, which includes a new bicycle and pedestrian bridge for the Longview Trail at a cost share of \$118,262.00, including construction and construction inspections for the new structure. The proposed First Amendment sets forth the responsibilities of the parties to execute the project, including Grandview's responsibilities for managing the project and associated federal Surface Transportation funds, and the County's responsibilities for payment of the County's share of the project.

This expenditure is consistent with Chapter 10 of the Jackson County Code 1030.2, Acquisition From Other Government.

A bidder must also download the current version of Expedite Bid software and the electronic bid submission (EBS) files from www.Bidx.com/mo/main.

All bidders are reminded that the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction Section 102 "Bidding Requirements and Conditions" includes important elements you should become familiar with prior to submitting a bid. Violation of this section is grounds to disqualify and reject bids by the Commission.


All successful bidders are required to remain in good standing with the Missouri Secretary of State to do business with the State of Missouri to be eligible to receive a contract for execution and during the performance of the contract.

MoDOT requires all successful bidders to be registered in MissouriBUYS. Registration with MissouriBUYS ensures prompt payment and allows vendors to update important information such as address changes or banking information.
