#### **Request Summary**

Awarding the Blue Springs Lake Roads Improvements contract, PR 2023-01, Federal Project No. FLAP064, to Superior Bowen Asphalt Co., LLC in Kansas City, Missouri under the terms and conditions of the Invitation to Bid 23-058.

The County entered into an agreement with the Federal Highway Administration — Eastern Federal Lands Highway Division, Missouri Department of Transportation to fund the improvements to roads at Blue Springs Lake through the Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP). The County was awarded \$760,000 for the project.

Olsson Associates prepared the Project Manual and Contract Documents for Bid No. ITB 23-058. The work includes subgrade preparation, mill and overlay sections, full depth replacement sections, aggregate shoulders, ditch reconstruction, pavement markings, erosion control, and drainage work.

Advertisements were posted by MoDOT on their RFP website, by the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department on the County's Bonfire website, and in the newspaper. A total of four (4) bids were submitted on November 7, 2023 at 2:00 pm. The summary of the bids are as follows:
