WHEREAS, the Contractor, in response to the Advertisement, has submitted to the County, in the manner and at the time specified, a bid in accordance with the terms of the Advertisement, and


WHEREAS, the County, in the manner prescribed by law, has opened, examined, and canvassed the Bid submitted, and has determined the aforesaid Contractor to be the lowest and best bidder for the work and has duly awarded to the said Contractor, a contract therefor, for the sum or sums named in the Contractor's Bid, a copy thereof being attached to and made a part of this contract.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the compensation to be paid to the Contractor and of the mutual agreements herein contained, the parties to these presents have agreed and hereby agree, the County for itself and its successors, and the Contractor for itself or themselves, and its or their successors and assigns, and its, or their executors and administrators, as follows:

ARTICLE I. That the Contractor shall: (a) furnish all tools, equipment, supplies, superintendence, transportation, and other construction accessories, services, and facilities; (b) furnish all materials, supplies, and equipment specified and required to be incorporated in and form a permanent part of the completed work; (c) provide and perform all necessary labor; and (d) in a good, substantial, and workmanlike manner and in accordance with the requirements, stipulations, provisions, and conditions of the contract documents as defined in the attached General Conditions, Special Conditions, and Technical Specifications, said documents forming the contract and being as fully a part thereof as if repeated verbatim herein, perform, execute, construct and complete all work included in and covered by the County's official award of this contract to the said Contractor, such award being based on the acceptance of the County of the Contractor's Bid.

ARTICLE II. That the County shall pay to the Contractor for the performance of the work embraced in this contract, and the Contractor will accept as full compensation therefore, the sum (subject to adjustment as provided by the contract) of

One Million Three Hundred Thirty Three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Four and 15/100 (\$ 1,333,334.15) for all work covered by and included in the contract award and designated in the foregoing Article I; payment thereof to be made in cash or its equivalent, in the manner provided in the General Conditions.

That the Contractor shall start work within ten (10) days following the date stipulated in a written order from the County to proceed with the work to be performed hereunder, and that the Contractor shall complete the work within the number of days, after the authorized starting date, stipulated in the attached Bid.

That the Contractor expressly warrants that they have employed no third person to solicit or obtain this contract in his behalf, or to cause or produce the same to be obtained upon compensation in any way contingent, in whole or in part, upon such procurement; and that the Contractor has not paid, or promised or agreed to pay, to any third person, in consideration of such procurement, or in compensation for services in connection therewith any brokerage, commission, or percentage upon the amount receivable by themselves here-under; and that the Contractor has not, in estimating the contract price demanded by themselves, included any sum by reason of any such brokerage, commission, or percentage, and that all monies payable to themselves hereunder are free from obligation of any other person for services rendered, or supposed to have been rendered, in the procurement of this contract. The Contractdor further agrees that any breach of this warranty shall constitute adequate cause for the annulment of this contract by the County and that the County may retain to its own use from any sums due or to become due hereunder an amount equal to any brokerage, commission, or percentage so paid, or agreed to be paid.

The County agrees to pay the Contractor in the manner and in the amount provided in the said specifications and bid.


