A total of Thirty-Four notices were distributed and one response was received. An Evaluation Team from the County Counselor's Office evaluated the proposals according to the following criteria: Experience and Qualifications 10%, Ability to meet all Requirements 20%, References 10%, Pricing 60%. Pursuant to Section 1054.6 of the Jackson County Code, 1984, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the award for the furnishing of Professional Mortuary Services to Muehlebach Mortuary Inc., dba Muehlebach Funeral Care of Kansas City, MO under the terms and conditions of Request for Proposal No. 34-17 as the lowest and best proposal received. This award is on an "As Needed" basis and does not obligate Jackson County to pay any specific amount. Review of the proposal for Professional Mortician Services submitted by Muehlebach Funeral Care finds they appear satisfactory in each of the areas necessary to satisfy our minimal requirements. Since there was unfortunately only one bid to consider, an ordinate ranking under the customary weigh factors in the 4 areas – experience, ability to meet requirements, references and cost are all somewhat meaningless and simply the ability to perform and reasonable costs dictate that Muehlebach appears appropriate for consideration.
