REQUEST SUMMARY	The Rock Island Rail Corridor Authority is seeking a resolution stating Legislative support for the Greenwood Connector Project, including support for several rounds of federal aid grant applications beginning this year. This year's funding application would fund the first two segments of a trail connecting the Rock Island Corridor Shared Use Path through Greenwood, MO to the MOPAC trail in Cass County, and ultimately connect to the KATY Trail. The project consists of four segments and we will seek federal aid funding in each phase from either the Surface Transportation Program (STP) or Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP). The federal aid funding will require a 20% match for each phase and we will pursue funding partnership agreements for the Lee's Summit and Greenwood segments of the project. Before applying for each federal grant cycle, we will seek legislative approval, and will provide a cost estimate and amount required for our local match. The incremental nature of this approach allows us to spread the financial burden out over a number years to minimize the impact on the County budget. If the federal funding applications are awarded for this project we will return to the Legislature to accept the grant and appropriate funding. Please see a detailed timeline below.
