Proper humidity and temperature control is essential for the conservation of the archaeological collection. The initial term of the Planned Service Agreement was for one year. This Addendum extends the term for an additional year. The Purchasing Department previously sought legislative approval on the Planned Service Agreement due to 1) the insurance release clause in Paragraph G on Page 13 of 18, and 2) the indemnity language in Paragraph H beginning on Page 13 of 18.
