WHEREAS, the County has been selected to receive funding through a grant under the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission (MHTC) Transportation Alternatives Fund Program to be used to construct a 1.5 mile trail and trailhead connecting the Rock Island Trail to the City of

WHEREAS, the attached Surface Transportation Program Agreement outlines the responsibilities of the MHTC and the County in connection with the project; and,
WHEREAS, the funding for this project will be provided pursuant to a follow-on agreement after the formal bidding process has been completed; and,
WHEREAS, the execution of the attached Agreement is in the best interests of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,
BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the attached Agreement is approved and that the County Executive is authorized to execute on behalf of the
County the attached Agreement and any other documents necessary to give effect to this Ordinance.
