RESOLUTION NO. 21203, March 20, 2023

INTRODUCED BY Venessa Huskey, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's and Prosecuting Attorney's Offices, the Department of Corrections, and the Drug Task Force have a need for law enforcement computer information services to check background information and obtain criminal histories; and,

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WHEREAS, these services were previously supplied by the Alert II System, which has been phased out and replaced by services supplied by the Regional Justice Information Service (REJIS) Commission of St. Louis, MO, a quasi-governmental entity formed to provide these services to public sector agencies; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1030.2, <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the award of a twelve-month term and supply contract with two twelve month options to extend to REJIS Commission of St. Louis, MO, for the furnishing of LEWeb law enforcement computer information services for the upcoming twelve-month period, pursuant to the determination that the services can be obtained from another governmental entity at a price below that quoted by a private vendor; and,

WHEREAS, this award is made on an as needed basis and does not obligate Jackson County to pay any amount, with the availability of funds for specific purchases remaining subject to annual appropriation; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made as recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing and that the Director of Finance and Purchasing is hereby authorized to execute a User Agreement with the REJIS Commission of St. Louis, MO, and any other documents necessary to give effect to the intent of this Resolution, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the Agreement, to the extent that sufficient appropriations to
