BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract, to the extent sufficient appropriations to the using spending agencies have been made in the current Jackson County budget, with an estimated annual usage of \$36,000.00. Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
