WHEREAS, COMBAT staff participated in the Community Anti-Drug Coalitions of America (CADCA) 50 Challenge to help raise awareness about the dangers of prescription and over-the-counter drug abuse; and,

WHEREAS, as part of this challenge, Jackson County COMBAT sponsored three town halls during National Medicine Abuse Awareness Month in October; and,

WHEREAS, Jackson County COMBAT has been awarded second place in this challenge and is the recipient of a \$500.00 award; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary in order to place the award funds in the proper spending account; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends said appropriation; now therefore,

<p>REQUEST SUMMARY</p>	<p>An ordinance authorizing the receipt of a donation from the Community Anti-Drug Coalitions of America and appropriate said funds to fund balance of the Anti- Drug Sales Tax Fund.</p> <p>One in 10 youth ages 12 through 17, or 2,400,000 children, has intentionally abused cough medicine to get high, and more than 6 million people ages 12 or older have abused a prescription drug. Jackson County COMBAT helped raise awareness about the dangers of prescription (Rx) drug abuse and over-the-counter (OTC) cough medicine abuse by taking part in the CADCA 50 Challenge. Jackson County sponsored three town halls, during National Medicine Abuse Awareness Month in October so that we can unite and have an even greater impact.</p> <p>Through the CADCA 50 Challenge, Jackson County is making a commitment to getting Rx and OTC medicine abuse on the radar screen of families across the county. COMBAT hosted a series of town hall meetings, about medicine abuse, in our community. Jackson County COMBAT was selected for 2<sup>nd</sup> place to receive CADCA's Dose of Prevention award. These funds will be used to continue the prescription drug awareness activities in Jackson County.</p>
