WHEREAS, MARC desires to donate to the County forensic equipment valued at \$142,000.00 and a 2011 Great Dane refrigerated trailer valued at \$89,000.00, for use by the Medical Examiner's Office in the event of mass fatality event; and,

WHEREAS, the Legislature, under article II, section 16 (21) of the Jackson County Charter, is empowered to acquire property for County purposes, and the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends accepting the said donation; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be authorized to accept the donation of forensic equipment and a 2011 Great Dane refrigerated trailer for use by the Medical Examiner's

Office; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to give effect to the intent of this Resolution.

REQUEST SUMMARY	The Mid America Regional Council has partnered with the Jackson County Medical Examiners Office to assist with mass fatality preparedness. Over the past 4 years the Jackson County Medical Examiners Office has worked with MARC in identifying needed equipment that would assist the JCMEO during a mass fatality event. MARC was able to allocate \$142,000.00 for the purchase of such equipment and \$89,000.00 for a refrigerated trailer. Working with the JCMEO, certain equipment was identified and was purchased by MARC. This equipment will enable the JCMEO to set up and operate a morgue operation separate from the Medical Examiners Office during a mass fatality event. Although the equipment and trailer purchased by MARC is not all the equipment needed for an operation morgue, the JCMEO has been able to add some of the smaller and less expensive pieces of forensic equipment to this cache which will assist the JCMEO to have an operational morgue. At this time MARC and the JCMEO are currently looking at grants and other funding to purchase the remainder of the equipment to have a completely stocked mobile morgue unit.
