

Jackson County LGBTQ+ Commission Bylaws

Article I – Name

Jackson County LGBTQ+ Commission

Article II – Purpose

To advise County leadership and promote equity, inclusion, and responsiveness to LGBTQ+ community needs.

Article III – Membership

Nine members consisting of district and at-large representatives appointed and confirmed per ordinance.

Article IV – Officers

Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary elected annually.

Article V – Meetings

The Commission shall meet no less than six (6) times per year and may meet more frequently as needed.

Article VI – Quorum

A majority of members (5) shall constitute a quorum.

Article VII – Committees

Standing and ad hoc committees may be created to support Commission work.

Article VIII – Attendance

Members are expected to attend regularly; repeated absences may result in removal.

Article IX – Ethics

Members shall comply with County ethics and conflict of interest policies.

Article X – Amendments

Bylaws may be amended by majority vote consistent with the ordinance.
