## Jeffrey A. Eisenbeis, Deputy Court Administrator/Family Court

Jeff earned a BS in Criminal Justice from the University of North Dakota and an MS in Logistics Management from Florida Tech. Jeff is also a graduate of the ICM's Court Management Program, the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College, and the U.S. Army Logistics Management College. He has been the Deputy Administrator since July 2004. Prior to his current appointment, he served as the Deputy Director of Family Court Services from 2001 to 2004, and as the Director of Budget and Support Services for the Family Court from 1998 - 2001. Before joining the Court, Jeff served 20 years in the U.S. Army in various assignments throughout the US and Europe, retiring as a Lieutenant Colonel. In addition to many operational logistics assignments, he served as the Chief of the FBI/US Army Hazardous Devices School where he was responsible for training civilian law enforcement bomb technicians from throughout the U.S. for the FBI. His last assignment was as a graduate faculty member at the U. S. Army Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth. Jeff has also been an adjunct faculty member in Baker University's MBA program where he taught statistics.
