While in office, Mr. Rhoads served on the Board of the **Mid-America Regional Council (MARC)**. This Bi-State organization dealt with regional issues in the metropolitan Kansas City area. While on that Board, Mr. Rhoads was elected to be the **Secretary** of MARC.

Also while in office, Mr. Rhoads served on the Board of the **Missouri Municipal League (MML)**. MML is an organization representing over 650 towns and cities that lobbied Legislators in the State of Missouri. Mr. Rhoads was elected to serve a one year term as **President of MML**.

VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES

Mr. Rhoads has served and continues to serve on various Boards and Commissions. Following is a listing of the various organizations on which he has served or currently serves.
