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## 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Mike Sanders, County Executive said the TIF lawsuit will be litigated on February 26, 2010 at 9 A.M. Discussion.

Bob Spence, County Legislator, asked about the status of the stadium agreement with Kansas City, Missouri.

Mike Sanders responded that Fred Siems, Chief Administrative Officer, is working with Troy Schulte, Acting City Manager, to resolve this matter. It is the City and County's moral obligation to fund the stadiums. However, Kansas City has not refunded to Jackson County the \$300,000.00 paid in 2009. Discussion.

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Bob Spence asked why the \$450,000.00 from the Missouri Department of Transportation (MODOT) is going into the General Fund.

Fred Siems responded that there is no obligation to put it in the debt retirement fund and the money must be used to fund the jail.

Bill Snyder, Acting County Counselor, said he could find no obligation to put it in the debt retirement or the road and bridge fund but he would look further into it and advise the Legislature of his findings.
