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## 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Mike Sanders, County Executive, announced that the Charter Review Task Force will have a public hearing on Wednesday, April 7, 2010 at 6:30 P.M. at the Howard Brown Public Safety Building, 1100 Smith Street, Blue Springs, Missouri.

He said the Assessment Department will be taking a \$564,000.00 cut from the State of Missouri and a reduction in force plan has begun. The Director of Assessment will give a report to the County Legislature soon.

Mike Sanders said there are also two more cuts from the State of Missouri; an additional \$250,000.00 reduction for the Assessment Department and a \$600,000.00 cut for the Corrections Department as a result of a reduction in the per diem for the jail (from \$22 to \$19). He encouraged everyone to lobby against these cuts as they are in a Senate Bill.

Discussion.

Henry C. Rizzo stated that the County Legislature will allow the Charter Review Commission to be an independent citizen process. Mike Sanders agreed that he will not be hands on either.
