A RESOLUTION awarding a twelve-month term and supply contract for the lease of vehicles for use by the Jackson County Drug Task Force to Lifestyle Leasing, Inc., of North Kansas City, MO, as a sole source purchase.

INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the County desires to lease vehicles for use by the Jackson County Drug Task Force; and,

WHEREAS, section 1030.1, <u>Jackson County Code</u>, eliminates the requirement for competitive bidding when items or services to be purchased can be obtained from only one source and requires notification of and approval by the Legislature on such sole source purchases exceeding \$25,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the officer in charge of the Drug Task Force has advised that, due to the unique needs of the Task Force for confidentiality and other law enforcement requirements, Lifestyle Leasing is the sole provider of leased vehicles on terms meeting the Task Force's needs in the Kansas City metropolitan area; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the lease of vehicles from Lifestyle Leasing of North Kansas City, MO, as a sole source provider of this service; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made as recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing, and that the Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary to the accomplishment of the award; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing is authorized to make all payments, including final payments on the contract, to the extent that sufficient appropriations to the using spending agency are contained in the then current Jackson County budget.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.

SUBJECT: 2011 Vehicle Lease Contract, Request for Sole Source Bid

The Jackson County Drug Task Force currently leases vehicles from Lifestyle Leasing. The vehicles are used for covert surveillance and undercover operations in narcotics investigations.

Because of the nature of narcotics investigations and the need for officer safety, confidentiality on the part of the vendor is of utmost importance. A covert law enforcement agency such as the JCDTF must deal with contractors and vendors that can be trusted not to divulge information that would compromise an officer or an investigation. Knowing the background and history of a vendor that we deal with on a one-to-one basis is a necessity. In addition, there is a requirement for a wide variety of types of vehicles and age of vehicles. And, there are occasions when a vehicle must be changed on short notice if it is compromised.

The JCDTF has researched costs from other vendors. All other lease or rental vehicle companies that were contacted in the Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri region do not rent to police agencies for undercover operations.

Lifestyle leasing, over the years, has consistently provided vehicles and service for the lowest cost. The proposed 2009 contract is bid at the 2007 and 2008 rates; \$660.00 for SUVs and \$650.00 for trucks with insurance included. Lifestyle Leasing has provided this service to other law enforcement agencies in the metropolitan area. They have demonstrated that they understand the need for confidentiality in dealing with law enforcement agencies. They have maintained that confidentiality.

For the above reasons I respectfully request that Lifestyle leasing be considered as a sole source bidder for 2011 automobile lease contract for the JCDTF.

AUTOMOBILE LEASE AGREEMENT

This Automobile Lease Agreement made and entered into this ____Day of January, 2011 by and between Lifestyle Leasing Inc., a Missouri Corporation (Lessor), and the Jackson County Drug Task Force (Lessee)

Whereas, Lessee desires from time to time to lease automobiles for undercover Assignment on both short and long term basis, and Whereas, Lessor agrees to provide vehicles to lessee under these conditions.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- Lessor agrees to lease to Lessee unmarked vehicles for lease terms of one year. Vehicles leased for one (1) year will be at the rate listed on attached schedule, "Attachment A". Scheduled leased vehicles are full maintenance leases as listed in Attachment A, Vehicle Lease Schedule.
- 2. Any vehicle leased under this agreement will have unlimited mileage.
- 3. All vehicles leased under this lease agreement shall be current or up to two year old model vehicles, unless specified otherwise, based on your request as to certain vehicles needed for rather specific circumstances.
- 4. Neither Lessor nor its agents, servants, or employees will disclose to anyone not employed by lessor the identity of any vehicles leased under this agreement.
- Lessor will provide full coverage insurance, and lessee shall be responsible for the \$1,000 deductible for collision and comprehensive damage to the leased vehicles, ordinary wear and tear excepted.
- Lessor agrees to provide a substitute for any vehicle that is mechanically or
 otherwise unsafe or unsound. Lessor would not provide replacement vehicle
 for routine warranty, or general maintenance or body shop repair.
- 7. Either party may terminate this agreement for failure of the other party to comply with the terms thereof. If Lessor or lessee needs to terminate lease, for any reason, lessor or lessee needs to give other party 30 days written notice of cancellation.
- 8. Lessor shall at its expense register and license all vehicles in the name of Lifestyle Leasing Inc. in Missouri and keep all licenses current on all vehicles. Lessor will provide Lifestyle with a sales tax exemption certificate in regards to the vehicles leased. If any tax, sales or personal property would be charged by the county or state, the lessee would be responsible for the payment.
- 9. Lessee is paying for the liability, collision and comprehensive coverage on vehicles leased with a \$1,000.00 deductible for comprehensive and collision included in the lease payment. Lifestyle does not provide any warranties or guarantees on vehicles above and beyond those of the manufacturer.

- 10. Lessee agrees to maintain each of the vehicles by using the oil change credit card furnished by lessor, and have other repairs reported to "Lifestyle", so Lifestyle can schedule other maintenance. Lessee is responsible for all the operating cost including gas and oil, and must use lubricating, and other materials that meet manufacturers specifications. Lessee agrees to keep said vehicles capable of passing such inspection as may be required to obtain a motor vehicle license in the state of Missouri. Lessee agrees to provide the motor vehicle inspection slip for any vehicle whose license may expire during the term of this agreement to lessor, so lessor can renew license plates, or bring the vehicle in to be inspected. Lessee is not responsible for maintenance of items due to Lessor's negligence. For example, a vehicle does not get proper oil changes and as a result the engine locks up. Lessee would be responsible for repairs.
- 11. This lease shall remain in force and effect as each vehicle covered for a period of 12 months from its respective date in service, and unless terminated as herein after provided, this lease thereupon shall be renewed annually as to all terms, covenants and provisions, here of for and additional term of one year, subject to availability of adequate funds. Adequate funds shall be understood to be monies which are made available through Federal Grants, Jackson County Drug Tax, and annual budget funding from City of Kansas City, Mo. This lease would terminate at the latest date of Dec 31, 2010: however, it could be renewed subject to new pricing on newer vehicles. Lessor would have an option to replace vehicles with similar vehicles during the term of the lease with lessor's approval. Lessor has the option on renewal in 2011 for an increase of no more than 5% in each additional year. Lessee would be notified 30 days in advance of any increase. This notification would not necessarily be at the same time as the automatic renewal period. Insurance renewal is based on the experience of he leased units, and is on a different renewal period than this contract. Lessor has the option of passing on any increase as a result of increased premiums.


