# 3 APPROVAL OF THE JOURNAL OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

# 4 HEARINGS

Jaime Guillen, Legislative Aide to Theresa Garza Ruiz, received his 5 year service pin.

Public Hearing regarding the property tax rates of Jackson County, Missouri, the Board of Services for the Developmentally Disabled (Sheltered Workshop), the Community Mental Health Fund and the Merchants and Manufacturers' Inventory Replacement. (Ordinances 4453 - #4456)

The public hearing was opened.

Bruce Eddy, Executive Director of the Jackson County Community Mental Health Fund, said the levy rate for the community mental health fund has not changed since 2008 and it serves 16,000 Jackson Countians. He thanked the County Legislature, the County Executive and the Administrative office for their assistance and support.

Duane Lewis, Director of Steppingstone, an organization that serves homeless teens, unwed mothers and young people phasing out of the system, said they have been receiving money from the community mental health fund for 20 years and have served 600 citizens in eastern Jackson County.

#### Discussion.

Janine Hron, Chief Executive Officer with Crittenton Children's Center, an organization that provides mental health services for children, stated that mental health funds provide hope and keep families together.

Brian Wilson, Captain with the Lee's Summit Police Department, talked about the Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) Program.

Discussion.

#### 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Mike Sanders, County Executive, spoke about the financial issue faced in Jackson County, Missouri. He said although Jackson County was looking at roughly a 6 percent revenue growth, the State of Missouri has passed on the following cuts: \$1.3 million cut in the per parcel rate for the Assessment Fund, \$800,000.00 cut from the Family Support Division and \$1.8 million cut because of the out of state sales tax on vehicles, boats and airplanes. He said there will be 35-40 positions cut in the Assessment and Prosecutor's Departments.

Jean Peters Baker, Prosecuting Attorney, said they have offered employees incentivized early retirement and the next process is to cut jobs. They are working to make it fair and equitable.

Shelley Kneuvean, Deputy Chief Administrative Officer, said it is a two-phased approach to accomplish a balanced budget. First they are offering incentivized resignation with a severance package and secondly they will eliminate jobs by keeping positions based on business needs.

Additionally, Mike Sanders reported that there will be a 10% increase in health insurance premiums.

#### Discussion.

Jean Peters Baker said the Family Support Division will need to be re-tooled. They will strive to maintain the same service delivery by cross training employees but the cut is substantial to this division. They will need to eliminate up to 17 positions in this department.

Fred Arbanas, County Legislator, asked Gary Panethiere, Legislative Auditor, to do a 20 year study on health insurance premiums for review by the County Legislature and Administration.

Mike Sanders presented a check to Sister Berta with Operation Breakthrough in the amount of \$17,000.00 from the County Executive Golf Tournament.
