AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$2,000.00 from the undesignated fund balance of the 2010 Grant Fund and authorizing the County Executive to execute an agreement with the Missouri Safety Center in acceptance of the Jackson County Sheriff's Office Child Passenger Safety Enforcement grant.

ORDINANCE #4235, September 13, 2010

INTRODUCED BY James D. Tindall, County Legislator

WHEREAS, automobile accidents are the number one killer of children and regular child safety seat and safety belt use is the most effective way to reduce fatalities in motor vehicles crashes; and,

WHEREAS, to combat this situation, the Sheriff's Office has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$2,000.00 by the Missouri Safety Center in furtherance of the Center's Child Passenger Safety Enforcement program for the period September 19 through September 25, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, the Sheriff recommends the use of funds for reimbursement of overtime used for the Child Passenger Safety Enforcement program promoting the use of safety seats and safety belts throughout the County pursuant to the attached agreement with the Missouri Safety Center; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place the grant funds in the proper spending

accounts; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation from the unappropriated surplus of the 2010 Grant Fund be and hereby is made:

**Child Passenger Safety
Enforcement Grant
September 19-25, 2010**

This contract is between Jackson County Sheriff's Dept. and the Missouri Safety Center for **September 19-25, 2010** to promote child safety seat and seat belt restraint usage throughout Missouri. The funding for this campaign is provided with Child Passenger Safety funds, so please emphasize safety seat violations along with seat belt violations during this period. The above named agency shall be defined as a sub-contractor to the Missouri Safety Center for this identified activity. Specific enforcement will be compliant with laws of the state of Missouri.

Agreements & Duties:

The enforcement agency agrees to provide staffing for the overtime enforcement a total claim **not to exceed \$2000**, and is the total funding provided for the enforcement period. The enforcement agency agrees to **submit enforcement statistics to MoDOT by way of the On-Line Reporting System** (instructions in packet) **and to submit manpower reports, outlining which officers worked the enforcement program with their overtime rate to the Missouri Safety Center (only after reporting activity online) and no later than October 1, 2010.** Prompt submission of the manpower report will allow the reimbursement check to be processed in a timely manner and sent to the agency for payment/recovery of paid salaries for officers doing overtime enforcement. **The enforcement agency also agrees to provide P.O.S.T. Certified Full or Part Time law enforcement officers for this overtime enforcement activity.** In addition, the agency agrees to provide to local media a pre & post press release (sample in packet) to notify the public of the enforcement effort taking place.


The Missouri Safety Center agrees to provide the reimbursement to the agency up to the allocated amount of funding provided for the weeks and to analyze and tally all participating agencies data into a statewide report to be submitted to Office of Highway Safety, Missouri Department of Transportation. Further, this data will be used to develop a statewide plan for addressing the seat belt usage rate and the subsequent enforcement plan for the state of Missouri.

Specifically, we are asking your agency to conduct specialized targeted high visibility child safety seat and seat belt restraint usage in your jurisdiction.

Notices: Right of Termination, If through any clause, the enforcement agency shall fail to fulfill in a timely and proper manner its obligations under this contact, or if the enforcement agency violates any of the agreements, or stipulations of this contact, the Missouri Safety Center shall have the right to terminate this contact and withhold further payment of any kind by giving written notice to the enforcement agency. The Missouri Safety Center and University of Central Missouri shall be the sole arbitrator of whether the enforcement agency is performing its obligations in a proper manner with reference to the quality performed by the terms of the contract. Either party may terminate this contract by giving written notice of such termination and specifying the effective date of the action. **All parties must comply with the provisions of 41 CFR Chapter 60 as defined by the U.S. Department of Labor.**

We the undersigned agree to the terms of the contract, and agree to participate in this statewide enforcement effort to keep our roadways safe for the citizens who travel them.
