		<b>Background:</b> The Anti-Drug Sales Tax fund authorizes the County to execute agreements and contracted service for the purpose of providing substance abuse treatment, prevention services, and other anti-drug and anti-violence initiatives in the community.					
		MOCSA is designed to provide individual and group counseling to survivors of sexual assault and child sexual abuse to decrease symptoms of trauma and thereby reduce the risk of turning to substances to cope.					
		Jackson County CASA is designed to provide a Staff Attorney and full time Staff Case Supervisors to serve abused and neglected children in the Jackson County Family Court system who are assigned to Drug Court. This special court works with families affected by drug addiction, assists parent (s) to become sober, places the children in a safe living environment and results in family reunification.					
		Amethyst Place, is designed to help women maintain sobriety by providing them with a drug and alcohol-free environment where they and their children can live in individual, fully furnished apartment's. The women are offered an opportunity to develop new parenting and independent living skills.					
	This funding was approved in the 2015 budget by the Jackson County Legislature. This resolution places it in the appropriate accounts for funding.
