WHEREAS, the Parks + Rec and Public Works Departments and the Jackson County Sheriff's Office all have need for animal or livestock feed and other agricultural supplies and equipment; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Finance and Purchasing has solicited bids on Invitation to Bid No. 24-038 for the furnishing of livestock feed, animal food, and agricultural supplies and equipment for use by various County departments; and,

WHEREAS, a total of 3,542 bid notifications were distributed, and one response was received and evaluated, from Feldman's Farm and Home of Liberty, MO; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1054.6 of the Jackson County Code, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends award of a twenty-four-month term and supply contract, with one twelve-month option to extend, for the furnishing of the needed supplies to Feldman's Farm and Home of Liberty, MO, as the lowest and best bid received; and,
