# 14 NEW BUSINESS

John Patrick Burnett, County Legislator, distributed to members of the Legislature a brief report on Union Station and the Bi-State Commission. He said last week it was reported by the media that the general contractor was chosen for Union Station. The amount of the contract is approximately \$34 million and will control approximately \$100-110 million, counting the sub-contractors. There was much discussion about whether the process and open meetings rules were followed. The Bi-State Commission met last Thursday and were advised by their attorneys that all procedures were properly followed. The bidding process used was modeled after the Federal Government which states that no information is released until after contracts are signed. Due to the confusion regarding this matter, media coverage was less than favorable. He advised the Legislature that there will be a tour of Union Station for elected officials in the near future and he encouraged everyone to attend.
