WHEREAS, seatbelt usage among Missouri motorists averaged 76% over the past five years; and,

WHEREAS, to combat this situation, the Sheriff's Office has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$4,000.00 by the Missouri Safety Center in furtherance of the Center's Click It or Ticket Overtime Enforcement program for the period May 24 through June 6, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, the Sheriff recommends the use of funds for reimbursement of overtime used for the Click It or Ticket Overtime Enforcement program promoting the use of safety seats and safety belts throughout the County pursuant to the attached contract with the Missouri Safety Center; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place the grant funds in the proper spending account; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation from the unappropriated surplus of the 2010 Grant Fund be and hereby is made:

Missouri Safety Center Click It or Ticket Overtime Enforcement Contract for May 24 through June 6, 2010

My 5/28/10

This contract is between <u>Jackson County Sheriff's Dept.</u> and the <u>Missouri Safety Center</u> for the week of May 24 – June 6, 2010, to conduct overtime enforcement activities to promote seat belt usage with a target of all vehicles. The above named agency shall be defined as a sub-contractor to the Missouri Safety Center for this identified activity. This enforcement will include all Hazardous Moving Violations and Non-Hazardous Violations. Specific enforcement requested is: speed, aggressive driving, DWI and Seat Belt and Child Safety Restraints.

Agreements & Duties:

The enforcement agency agrees to provide staffing for the overtime enforcement, for a total claim not to exceed \$4000, for the enforcement period. The enforcement agency agrees to submit, to the Missouri Safety Center, as part of the request for reimbursement; the manpower reports outlining which officers worked the enforcement and fax it to 660-543-4482 on or before July 6, 2010. In addition, the enforcement agency shall submit to the Highway Safety Online Mobilization Reporting System (www.modot.mo.gov), as part of the request for reimbursement, the citation totals for this enforcement campaign before the payment will be processed. This allows for reimbursement checks to be processed back in a timely manner to the agency for payment/recovery of paid salaries for officers doing overtime enforcement. The enforcement agency agrees to request each officer on overtime to make at least 3 contacts per hour, (excluding DWI arrests). The agency will be evaluated based upon activities, as to future contracts for enforcement activities.

The enforcement agency also agrees to provide only P.O.S.T. Certified Full Time or Reserve law enforcement officers for this overtime enforcement activity. In addition, the agency agrees to provide to local media a pre & post press release (sample in packet) to notify the public as the enforcement efforts taking place each month.

The Missouri Safety Center agrees to provide reimbursement up to the allocated amount to the above named agency for the enforcement period, and to analyze and tally all participating agencies data into a statewide report to be submitted to the Highway Safety Division, Missouri Department of Transportation. Furthermore, this data will be used to develop a statewide plan for addressing the seat belt usage rate and the subsequent enforcement plan for the state of Missouri.

Notices: Right of Termination, If through any clause, the enforcement agency shall fail to fulfill in a timely and proper manner its obligations under this contract, or if the enforcement agency violates any of the agreements, or stipulations of this contract, the Missouri Safety Center shall have the right to terminate this contract and withhold further payment of any kind by giving written notice to the enforcement agency. The Missouri Safety Center and the University of Central Missouri shall be the sole arbitrator of whether the enforcement agency is performing its obligations in a proper manner with reference to the quality performed by the terms of the contract. Either party may terminate this contract by giving written notice of such termination and specifying the

effective date of the action. All parties must comply with the provisions of 41 CFR Chapter 60 as defined by the U.S. Department of Labor.

We the undersigned agree to the terms of the contract, and agree to participate in this statewide enforcement effort to keep our roadways safe for the citizens who travel them.
