AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$450.00 from the fund balance of the 2008 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund to cover a grant received from the United States Executive Office of the President's Midwest High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Investigative Support Center for use by the Jackson County Sheriff's Office and authorizing the County Executive to execute an addendum to the agreement with Woody Poole, the designated investigative analyst, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$450.00.

ORDINANCE #4014, July 14, 2008

INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 3970, dated January 22, 2008, the Jackson County Legislature did appropriate \$66,009.00 in acceptance of a grant received from the United States Executive Office of the President's Midwest High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Investigative Support Center for an investigative analyst to be retained on contract for use by the Jackson County Sheriff's Office; and,

WHEREAS, due to the increased price of fuel, Midwest HIDTA has authorized an increase to the fuel allowance covered under this grant, at an increased cost of \$50.00 per month; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place these grant funds in the appropriate spending accounts; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the

following appropriation be and hereby is made from the unappropriated surplus of the 2008

Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund:





FIRST ADDENDUM

THIS FIRST ADDENDUM made and entered into this 24 day of Sept., 2008, by and between Jackson County, Missouri, (hereinafter called "County"), and Woody L. Pool, (hereinafter called "Analyst").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Analyst and County entered into an Agreement dated March 4, 2008, whereunder Analyst agreed to provide investigative services through a Midwest High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Investigative Support Center Grant; and,

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to increase the scope of the services to be provided by Analyst to County, at an increased cost.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, County and Analyst respectively agree with each other as follows:

1. Except as expressly provided herein, all provisions of the Agreement between Analyst and County shall remain in full force and effect.
2. Due to the rising cost of gas, the fuel allowance for Analyst shall be increased in the amount of \$50.00 per month, for a total fuel allowance of \$300.00 per month, thereby increasing the total cost of the contract by \$450.00.
3. This Addendum shall be effective upon its execution.
4. This First Addendum to Agreement, together with the Agreement of March 4, 2008, incorporate the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.
