REQUEST SUMMARY	In partnership with Central Jackson County (CJC) Fire District and the City of Lee's Summit Fire Department, the Park Department has been working to identify areas for additional storm siren coverage. At this time, Longview Lake is covered by existing sirens; however, there were gaps in coverage in the Lake Jacomo and Blue Springs Lake areas. Working with these two agencies, the Park Department will purchase and install two new sirens and relocate two existing sirens provided by CJC. Through these intergovernmental agreements, CJC will be responsible for maintaining, insuring, and sounding two of the sirens. Lee's Summit Fire Department will be responsible for maintaining, insuring, and sounding the				
	other two sirens. Depending on weather, it is our intention to install these sirens as soon as possible. An RLA with the needed funding is being presented to the Legislature as well. Jackson County will fund the upfront purchase and installation costs associated with the four sirens; and CJC and Lee's Summit Fire will then assume all responsibilities going forward.				

		Once installed, these sirens will ensure proper coverage for the lakes, the campgrounds, and the children's summer day camp ensuring a higher level of public safety.
