Awarding a twenty-four month term and supply contract with three twelve-month options to extend for the furnishing of door and restroom partition replacement, repair, maintenance, and associated services for use by various County departments to DH Pace Company, Inc., d/b/a Overhead Door Company of Olathe, KS, under the terms and conditions of Invitation to Bid No. 34-15.
