REQUEST SUMMARY	<p>A resolution authorizing the Director of Finance &amp; Purchasing to make payment for a COMBAT sponsorship to Boy Scouts of America, funded by the County's Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund for the 2016 fiscal year, for the purpose of promoting anti-drug and anti-violence activities and purposes, not to exceed \$2000.00.</p> <p><b>Background:</b> The Anti-Drug Tax Fund authorizes the County to execute agreements and contracted service for the purpose of providing substance abuse treatment and prevention, grant match and other anti-drug and anti-violence initiatives in the community.</p> <p>Boy Scouts of America hosts the Frontier District program which is a non-traditional, Scout outreach program within the underserved communities in the Greater Kansas City Metro Area. This program helps over 3,800 young men in the urban core build strong character, sense of citizenship, and long-lasting skills to improve their lives. In the summer months, youths are invited to attend the Scout camp which costs between \$60 and \$325, depending on the age group. This costs are unaffordable for many of the eligible youth and puts a burden on the families of these young men. COMBAT funds would allow camp scholarships to a few of these young men that will fit in the mission of COMBAT.</p>

This program helps over 3,800 young men in the urban core build strong character, a sense of citizenship and long-lasting skills to improve their lives. 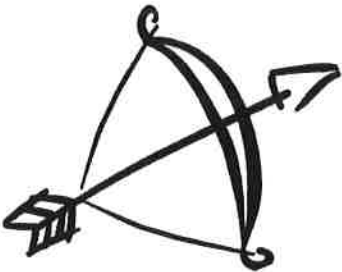
