

Charles Iseman is the long-serving law enforcement leader who served as the Chief of Police for the Grandview Police Department in Missouri. He officially retired on Friday, May 22, 2026.

Chief Iseman dedicated 35 years to the City of Grandview. In May 2011, he stepped into the role of Chief of Police, where he served for 15 years.

Before ascending to Chief, he worked across multiple operational areas starting in 1991, serving as a patrol officer, SWAT operator, undercover detective, patrol sergeant, investigations lead, and administration division commander.

Throughout his career, Chief Iseman extended his leadership to regional organizations, serving on the executive boards of the Jackson County Drug Task Force and the Metro Chiefs & Sheriffs Association.

He holds a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice/Law Enforcement Administration from Central Missouri State University, and he is a member of Alpha Phi Sigma (the National Criminal Justice Honor Society).
