#### **Request Summary**

The Public Works and Parks + Recreation Departments require a Term and Supply Contract for the furnishing of General Contracting Services. The Purchasing Department issued Invitation to Bid No. 49-21 in response to those requirements.

A total of 146 notifications were distributed with Five (5) responses received and evaluated. Please see Bid Recap attachment.

The Evaluation Committee consisting of the Public Works and Parks + Rec Departments recommend award to: Hartline Construction LLC of Kansas City, MO, NW Rogers Construction Inc of Blue Springs, Mo and Universal Construction Company, Inc of Kansas City, KS based on the lowest and best bids with multiple options for service depending on County needs and accessibility.

Pursuant to Section 1054.6 of the Jackson County Code, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the award of a Twelve Month Term and Supply Contract with One Twelve Month Option to extend for the furnishing of General Contracting Services under the terms and conditions of Invitation to Bid No. 49-21 as the lowest and best bidders.

The annual estimated usage is \$380,000 for the following County Departments:

Parks + Recreation/Facilities Management: \$370,000

Public Works: \$10,000
