INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Resolution 17597, dated May 23, 2011, the Legislature did award a contract for LEWeb law enforcement computer information services to the Regional Justice Information Services (REJIS) Commission, of St. Louis, MO, as an acquisition from another governmental entity, at a cost to the County for 2011 not to exceed \$11,592.00; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 17657, dated August 11, 2011, the Legislature did authorize a first addendum to the contract with REJIS to allow the Sheriff's Office to access information for the Conceal Carry Weapons Program; and,

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Multijurisdictional Drug Task Force is also in need of a subscription for the REJIS LEWeb law enforcement computer information services, at an additional cost to the County for 2011 not to exceed \$397.50; and,

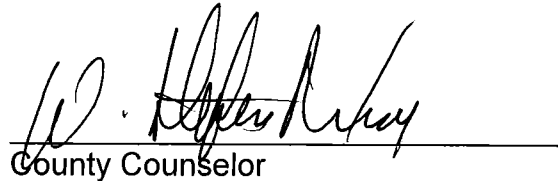
BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to execute for the County a second addendum to the agreement with the REJIS Commission, of St. Louis, MO; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreement, and all addenda thereto.

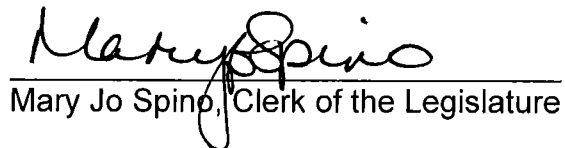

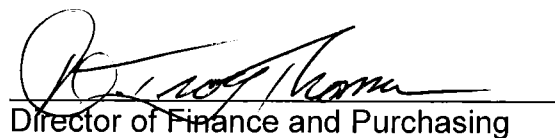

| REQUEST SUMMARY | <p>On May 23, 2011, Resolution No. 17597 was passed by the Legislature awarding a Twelve Month Contract, with Two Twelve Month Options to Extend with Rejis (Regional Justice Information Service Commission) for subscription services to check background information, obtain criminal history and share information with other law enforcement agencies in the State of Missouri. This subscription is used by the Sheriff's Office, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, the Family Support Division and the Department of Corrections. The Rejis (Regional Justice Information Service Commission) system replaces the Alert II System that was previously used by these departments. The Drug Task Force also requires a subscription with Rejis.</p> <p>Pursuant to Section 1030.2 of the Jackson County Code, 1984, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends this Addendum to the existing User Agreement be issued for the Drug Task Force to Rejis (Regional Justice Information Service Commission) of St. Louis, MO as an Acquisition from Other Government.</p> | | | | | | | | | | | | |
