Justification

GAM requesting a one year no cost extension of the 2021 JAG Grant, Award 15PBJA-21-GG-01611-JAGX, for the County of Jackson County and City of Kansas City.

Jackson County is requesting a one year no cost extension to expand two assistant prosecutor, data and information analyst, assistant prosecutor/diversion manager positions and travel/training funds to send staff members to future trainings through 9/30/25.

City of Kansas City is requesting a one year no cost extension to expand the Neighborhood Services liaison position, dumpster rentals and general supplies for staff/program; SAVE KC Program client advocate, social case worker, program director positions, program operational expenses and professional services; and Violence Reduction Program executive program manager position, neighborhood conflict mediation services through 9/30/25.
