SECOND ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT

(Extension to 2016 COMBAT Prevention)

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, by Resolution 19008, dated November 23, 2015, the County and Organization did enter into an agreement whereby Organization agreed to provide anti-drug and/or anti-violent crime prevention activities, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$90,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 19346, dated December 16, 2016, the Legislature did increase the maximum sum available under this Agreement by \$5,000.00, and authorize an extension to this Agreement through March 1, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Drug Commission has recommended an additional extension to this Agreement for these services, at no additional cost to the County; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 19480, dated May 9, 2017, the County Legislature has authorized the County Executive to enter into this Second Addendum to Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein contained, County and Organization do hereby additionally agree as follow:
