## 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, said she was very excited about how our baseball team has been doing since opening day. After going 9 and 0 to begin the 2003 season, our Kansas City Royals came back down to earth Sunday in a 6-1 loss to Cleveland at Jacobs Field. But, it was the best start in the majors since 1987. That's very good for the Royals, and very good for Kansas City.

Katheryn announced that reassessment notices on property taxes will begin going out this coming weekend for all 272,000 real estate parcels in Jackson County, Missouri. This is a State mandated reassessment that covers all real estate property, residential, agricultural and commercial. All property owners will receive a notice, even if there values did not change.

State law requires counties to reassess real estate property every two years, based upon fair market value. Fair market value is the price a willing buyer will pay a willing seller. As a result of this 2003 reassessment, the average increase for Jackson County is 13%. Our average increase is comparable with Clay County notices which just went out. It should be noted that the majority of properties experiencing increases greater than 15% in Jackson County were specialty properties such as condos, townhouses and residential rental properties.

A plan is in place to help answer any questions from citizens. We have extensive information on the county web site at www.jacksongov.org. This information includes general history on reassessment and frequently asked questions. We suggest citizens try that first before calling the phone number on their notice. If they believe the assessment on their house is not the fair market value, there is an informal appeal process. Citizens can phone in for an appointment with just our assessment staff. If they are still not satisfied, they can appeal to the Board of Equalization which meets in July. Taxpayers who still have questions or wish to appeal the assessment can call the phone number on their notice beginning Thursday. If a citizen chooses to call, they should do so with their notice in hand.

She stated that circuit breaker information will be put on the County's website and a notice will also be included in the tax bills. Public Service Announcements on television and radio are also being considered to inform the public.

Michael O'Flaherty said he would assume his position as Director of Assessment in 3 weeks. He stated that reassessments are done county-wide in odd numbered years.

Robert A. Stringfield said he attended a meeting with Bob Mann of Bridging the Gap, the largest non-profit organization for recycling. He learned that Jackson County is number one in the midwest and in the country for our recycling efforts. He asked the administration if they would contact Mr. Mann and schedule a presentation to the legislature.

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, said she would be happy to contact Mr. Mann.
