RESOLUTION #17515, February 22, 2011

INTRODUCED BY Bob Spence, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the County desires to purchase Haydite, an aggregate used in road surfacing and repair, for use by the Public Works Department; and,

WHEREAS, section 1030.1, Jackson County Code, 1984, eliminates the requirement for competitive bidding when the items to be acquired can be obtained from only one source; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the award of a twelve-month term and supply contract for the furnishing of Haydite to Buildex Corporation of Ottawa, KS, as a sole source provider, because Buildex is the only known provider of this commodity in the region; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, MO, that award be made as recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing, and that the Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary to the accomplishment of the award; and,



SUBJECT: Sole Source Purchase of Haydite

I am requesting an RLA be prepared and submitted to the Legislature requesting approval of the Sole Source purchase of Haydite from Buildex Corporation for the year of 2011.

This vendor has provided Haydite for the Public Works Department since 2007. We utilize this commodity for our chip seal operation relating to the yearly Road Program, for patching on previously chip sealed roads and for patching with our one-man patching truck.

We plan to spend \$550,000 with Buildex. The request for 2011 has increased from 2010 due to work scheduled on the 2011 Road Program. Funds are budgeted in the 004-1506-57440 account. Total funds budgeted for 2011 in the 57440 account are \$675,000.

RE: Haydite – Rock for Patching – Sole Source 2011

I am asking for your approval and Ms. Kneauvean's approval for the Sole Source purchase of the commodity Haydite for 2011.

As explained in our request since 2007, Haydite is a compressed aggregate substance that is fired to a lightweight consistency, small in size, and perfectly clean. In our area, the commodity can only be purchased from the company Buildex. This product is not sold through local vendors and is a necessity to purchase locally for delivery purposes.

As scheduled, Road Maintenance will be responsible for chip seal activities associated with our 2011 Road Program. All chip seal will require Haydite. The commodity is also required for patching with our One-Man Pothole Patching truck, Haydite is used for strip reconstruction, and any patching activities required on existing chip seal roads that currently have a chip seal surface constructed of Haydite. Our current rock contract vendor does not supply any products that would be suitable for this type of surface treatment. The purchase of aggregate for routine maintenance throughout the year can still be purchased through our contract vendor, Barber Quarry.


We request to spend \$550,000 to purchase the product Haydite from the company Buildex. If you have any questions, give me a call at 847-7071.

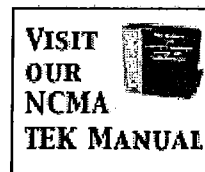

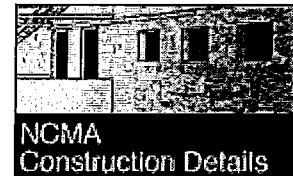
