## FIRST ADDENDUM COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT Teens in Transition - No Violence Alliance Project

THIS FIRST ADDENDUM, made and entered into on this day of october, 2014, by and between JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI, hereinafter called "the County" and KANSAS CITY METROPOLITAN CRIME COMMISSION, 3100 Broadway, Suite 226, Kansas City, MO 64111, hereinafter referred to as "Crime Commission."

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Prosecuting Attorney's Office is participating in the Teens in Transition Program as part of the No Violence Alliance (NoVA) Project, a collaborative initiative between key law enforcement leaders in Kansas City, the regional administrator of probation and parole, and the U.S. Attorney's Office, to reduce violent crime in Kansas City's urban core through a mix of law enforcement and social service components; and,

WHEREAS, the Teens in Transition Program is a summer outreach project for juveniles identified to be in the social network of violent groups in Kansas City, Missouri; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 18575, date July 28, 2014, the Legislature did authorize an agreement with the Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission for furnishing of off-duty Kansas City police officers to supervise a group of juveniles in the Teens in Transition program, at a cost to the County in the amount of \$7,735.00; and

WHEREAS, the Teens in Transition Program has been a success this past summer,

with 27 juvenile participants, but has encountered a budget shortfall; and,

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Drug Commission has recommended this Addendum to the Cooperative Agreement with the Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission for the furnishing of additional funding for the NoVA Teens in Transition Program, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$12,200.00; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 18597, dated August 29, 2014, the Legislature of Jackson County authorized the execution of this Addendum.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, County and Legal Counsel respectively agree with each other as follows:

- 1. Except as expressly provided herein, all provisions of the Cooperative Agreement dated August 29, 2014, between Crime Commission and County shall remain in full force and effect.
- 2. The maximum sum to be paid by County to Crime Commission shall be increased by the amount of \$12,200.00, for a maximum total of 19,935.00.
- 3. This First Addendum to Agreement together with the Cooperative Agreement dated August 29, 2014, incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.
