Two proposals for pre-employment psychological examinations were evaluated by three Department of Corrections personnel: Carmen Hayes, HR Administrator; Lt. Johnathan Baldree, on assignment as Job Recruiter; and Laura Scott, Assistant Director of Administration. Proposals were received by 1)PsychLogic and 2)Forensic Psychology Associates. Respondents were evaluated first on: 1)Responsiveness to the RFP; 2)Qualifications and Experience; and 3)References. Following this, respondents were evaluated related to 4)Pricing.

Both proposals met all minimum requirements of the RFP. Both respondents have been in this business for several years and have above average to outstanding qualifications and experience, specifically in the fields of law enforcement, and corrections. Both were above average to outstanding related to positive feedback from references. The Superintendent of Safety and Enforcement for the Jackson County Parks and Recreation Department had particularly good things to say about PsychLogic, including: "Dr. Harris has provided valuable insight for the selection process...Scheduling is timely. Communication is spot on. Assessment results and reporting are quick, insightful and handled in a professional manner..." References for Forensic Psychology Associates report that: "They have been easy to work with..." and they, "do not rubber stamp candidates or evaluations..." and are, "highly recommended."

Across the first three categories of evaluation, PsychLogic scored highest, and PsychLogic's pricing was also lowest, and most affordable.

The evaluation team recommends that PsychLogic be awarded the bid for pre-employment psychological examinations. Corrections expects to spend up to \$60,000 annually on this contract.

4.6.10 Pricing information (to be placed in separate envelope included only with original proposal)

Cost of evaluations: The charge for the basic battery of tests (MMPI-2 and NEO), including interview and written report, is \$300. If the Millon or Personality Assessment Inventory or other psychological tests are administered, there is an additional charge, \$45 per test, for scoring but no additional charge for the report itself.

Fees for other consulting: Fees for expert witness testimony are billed at \$250 per hour. Fees for critical incident debriefing are billed at \$175 per hour. Fees for organizational consultation vary by project but generally are \$200 per hour.
