Bob Spence, County Legislator, made the following comments:

I'm going to vote for this budget because we need to move the process forward and I am pleased that we are about to do something for the 44% of our employees who are the lowest paid.

I want my colleagues to know however, that I am disappointed in the continued give-away of general fund money to outside agencies. These agencies are, for the most part, well meaning and deserving. But, I am against the county funding them for three main reasons:

First, I beleive it is an inappropriate use of tax dollars.

Second, the good citizens of this County tax themselves almost \$16.7 million for health, \$10.5 million for parks, \$16.1 million for roads and bridges (\$4.5 million of this goes to the sheriff's department), \$18.2 million in anti-drug sales taxes, \$10.2 million for Union Station restoration, \$1.0 million for the 9-1-1 system and almost \$0.5 million for domestic abuse and homeless assistance. All that comes to \$73.2 million.

Then they tax themselves another \$36.3 million for the general operations of the County and the court system takes amost \$24.0 million of that.

It doesn't take a lot of effort to see that the County is strapped for cash. It's no wonder we have a hard time paying our employees a living wage. Especially when we give \$300,000.00 to outside agencies.

Third, the biggest part of this give-away goes to Kansas City. Independence gets a little bit but the rest of eastern Jackson County gets almost nothing.

As I said, I'm disappointed this budget continues the give-away. I understand that it would be very difficult to just cut them off. But, I hoped we would start a weaning process - say over a three-year period - so we could use the money to provide the basic services we must provide and pay our people a living wage.

I will vote for this budget, but as the individual requests come before this body I will vote against them with the exception of certain amounts for MARC and the University Extension Center.
