<p>REQUEST SUMMARY</p>	<p>A resolution authorizing the Director of Finance & Purchasing to make payment to Kingsway Christian College and Theological Seminary of Missouri, Inc., for the purpose of promoting anti-drug and anti-violence purposes, funded by the County's Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund for the 2015 fiscal year, not to exceed \$1500.00.</p> <p>Background: Kingsway Christian College and Theological Seminary of Missouri, Inc. is presenting ReMade, a first time Faith Based/Clinical Treatment conference November 20-21, 2015; at the Adam's Mark in Kansas City, Missouri. One of the goals of this conference is to begin to dispel the myth and stigma for people of faith getting professional mental health and addictions services. It is targeted at entire families, including children, teens and elders. Information will be presented geared towards removing barriers to seeking and receiving professional help and resources for behavioral health challenges, specifically addressing addiction and unbalanced anger.</p> <p>The Drug Commission has authorized COMBAT administration to seek opportunities to expand the reach of COMBAT beyond partners and funded programs. ReMade provides an excellent opportunity to reach faith based populations. With this approval, COMBAT will have expended \$9,500.00 of the maximum \$10,000.00 per year authorized by the Drug Commission for sponsorships.</p>
