5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, said the fire drill planned for today at the Kansas City Courthouse and the Independence Annex was postponed per the advice of the Sheriff's Department. It will be rescheduled for a later date due to America's military response that began yesterday. She said that last week meetings were held for the floor leaders at both locations and a mock evacuation drill was conducted at the end of the meetings.

She announced that she has formed a task force to examine and evaluate the issue of Park Rangers carrying firearms. The task force will be charged with looking at current practices and policies of the Ranger Department and recommend changes that they feel need to be made so that the rangers can fulfill their duties in the safest and most efficient manner possible. The task force will be chaired by Fred Mills, Police Chief of Independence, Missouri as he brings many years of experience as a Missouri Highway Patrolman and as Director of the Highway Patrol. Other members include: Brian Williams, with Stinson, Mag, Fizzell; Calvin Willford with Move Up; Tom Haley with Lee's Summit Christian Church and a member of the Human Relations Commission in Lee's Summit, Missouri; and Dennis Waits, County Legislator - 3rd District. She has also contacted Bud Hertzog, a previous legislator from Lee's Summit, Missouri but has not heard back from him yet. She said she is confident that a task force comprised of people with various qualifications will come to conclusions that completely serve what is in the best interests of all Jackson County residents.

Victor E. Callahan, Chairman, said he hopes that the views of the task force committee members are balanced on the issue of arming park rangers in Jackson County.

Katheryn Shields announced that this is National Mental Health Awareness Week. This is a week to recognize that the mentally ill are valued members of our community, as well as a time to bring attention to the issues surrounding mental health. She reminded everyone that the artwork featured in the Mental Health Art Exhibit was moved from the downtown Courthouse to the Independence Annex where it will remain through the end of the week.

She said over \$900 was raised last Friday at the lockup that took place at the downtown Courthouse for the Combined Charities Campaign Kickoff. She thanked everyone who participated and helped make the entire campaign a success.

The Missouri Town 1855 Fall Festival was attended by over 10,000 Jackson County residents. She commended the Parks Department staff on this successful event.
