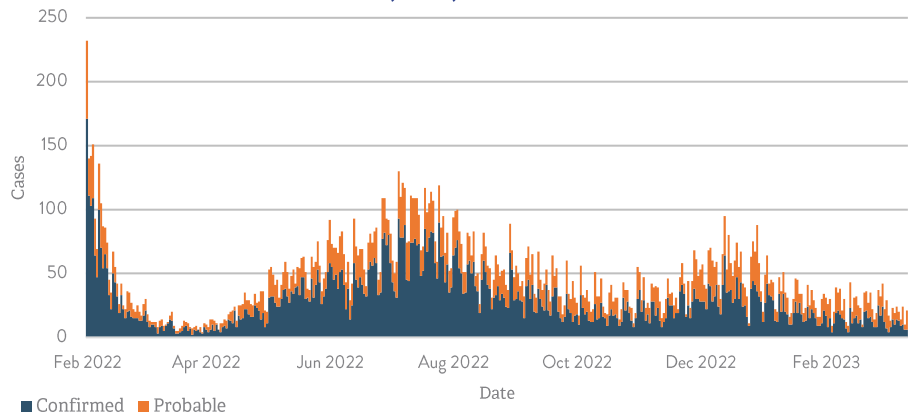

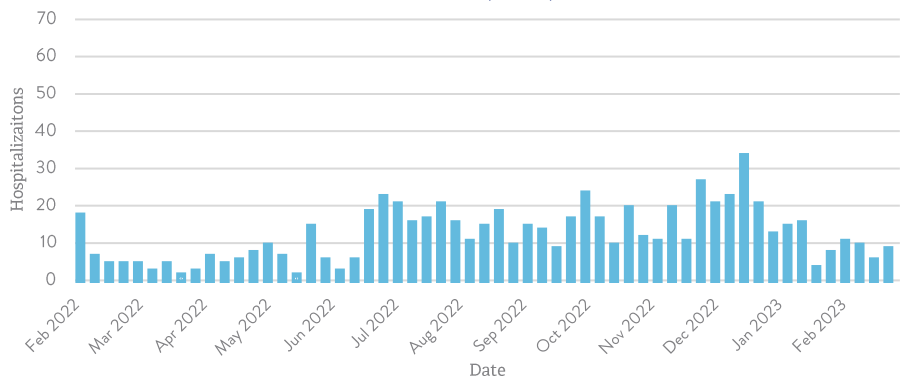

The Assessment Department has an ongoing need to obtain and use mortgage loan information services as related to the purchase and sales of commercial property throughout the Kansas City metro area. TreppLoan Suite is provided by Trepp, Inc.; as a unique service; including a large commercially available database of securitized mortgages; an institutional-grade analytics platform with multiple reference points for debt, equity, operating, and market performance analysis; a unique combination of comps, benchmarks, historical financials and numerous proprietary derived fields such as implied cap rate, spreads and property sub-types. Trepp has direct contracts with lenders for the type of information we would find extremely useful in valuing commercial property. By contracting with lenders, Trepp gets information that is not typically public information.

A contract with Trepp will afford us the ability to have access to a broad scale of commercial mortgage loan information which we have not previously had available to us. We believe the Jackson County Assessment Department will benefit greatly by using these products and services in the areas of increased efficiency and staff productivity; for property valuation, BOE and STC appeals and hearings for commercial properties.

TreppLoan Suite is provided by Trepp, Inc.; as a unique service; including a large commercially available database of securitized mortgages; an institutional-grade analytics platform with multiple reference points for debt, equity, operating, and market performance analysis; a unique combination of comps, benchmarks, historical financials and numerous proprietary derived fields such as implied cap rate, spreads and property sub-types. Trepp has direct contracts with lenders for the type of information we would find extremely useful in valuing commercial property. By contracting with lenders, Trepp gets information that is not typically public information. A contract with Trepp will afford us the ability to have access to a broad scale of commercial mortgage loan information which we have not previously had available to us. We believe the Jackson County Assessment Department will benefit greatly by using these products and services in the areas of increased efficiency and staff productivity; for property valuation, BOE and STC appeals and hearings for commercial properties.

Our extensive research on this type of vendor includes the following information on companies that may, initially, appear to be similar but none of these provide anything like the information that Trepp can provide for us:

FRED: This product/service appears to be used by policymakers, researchers, students, teachers, business professionals, journalists, and anyone who's interested in accessing data to make informed decisions. FRED provides data collected from the Federal Reserve to provide economic statics. This is not information we would use in the Assessment Department as it appears to be designed for economists.

PUDB: This appears to be a Python debugging tool. This is nothing we could use for our needed purpose.

SIFMA Securities Industry and Financial Market Association:
The Securities Industry and Financial Markets Association is a United States industry trade group representing securities firms, banks, and asset management companies. This is nothing we could use for our needed purpose.

S & P Global: Providing rich data, research, credit ratings, benchmarks, ESG solutions, and more. Unlock expansive insights across markets and industries. Actionable research. Insightful commentary. Key economic benefits. Robust data & analytics. Types: data, analytics. It appears that their focus is more on economic data. This is nothing we could use for our needed purpose.

The Carlisle Group: This is a software company. The software is called CAS. CAS is used by companies for tape-cracking and importing data, reporting, edit and error analysis, exporting data, underwriting and automated data scrubbing, inventory monitoring, secondary marketing, shadow servicing, pricing, research and analysis, and cash flow analysis. This is nothing we could use for our needed purpose.

RE Capital USA: This is a subscription service and similar to the Business Journal, they provide articles on various business topics throughout the country. This is nothing we could use for our needed purpose.

We are unaware of any similar company to Trepp, Inc. who offers the same services in an immediate manner as required for the seamless and consistent work of the 2023 reassessment and the ongoing appeals process. We believe Trepp, Inc. to be a sole source vendor for the specific services we need.

We are requesting a thirty-six-month contract with Trepp, Inc. The contract is subject to annual appropriation and can be terminated if funds are not appropriated. The fees quoted are at a discounted rate due to the 36-month contract. Our annual fee for 2023-2024 for this licensing is \$90,022.68. Our 2023-2024 Trepp expenditure for this initial contract is not expected to exceed \$90,022.68.

This will be funded from Assessment Department funding account 045-1902-56663; line-item Software as a Service.





Jackson County, Missouri has annually entered into a Subscription Agreement with Rejis (Regional Justice Information Service) Commission for LEWeb Subscription Services and other associated services to check background history, obtain criminal history and share information with other law enforcement agencies in the State of Missouri.

Pursuant to Section 1030.2 of the Jackson County Code, the Purchasing Department recommends the award of a Twelve (12) Month Term and Supply Contract, with Two (2) Twelve (12) Month Extensions, for LEWeb Subscription Services and other associated services for the Sheriff's Office, the Department of Corrections, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, Municipal Courts, Drug Task Force and the Family Support Division to Rejis Commission of St. Louis, Missouri as an Acquisition from Other Government.

This Award is made on an "as needed" basis and does not obligate Jackson County, Missouri to pay any specific amount. The annual estimated spend for use by Various County Departments is \$57,000.00. The availability of funds for specific purchases is subject to annual appropriations.

Above estimated annual spend does not match Jackson County Agencies -Billings as of 2-23-2023 spreadsheet as the MSHP MULES connection fee is expected to increase, REJIS is anticipating a price increase for services and the spreadsheet does not include "billable support" where REJIS troubleshoots, updates, or adds a device.




