WHEREAS, the Jackson County Drug Commission has recommended agreements with 12<sup>th</sup> Street Heritage Development Corporation for its Re-Entry Program at a cost to the County not to exceed \$12,500.00, and with the Kansas City Crime Commission for its DNA Back-Log Program, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$3,722.00, for anti-drug prevention services from January 1, 2012, to December 31, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, the execution of agreements for the services of these agencies is in the best interests of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute agreements with 12<sup>th</sup> Street Heritage Development Corporation and the Kansas City Crime Commission, at an aggregate cost to the County not to exceed \$16,222.00, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreements.



Dear Dr. Daniels-Young:

The Twelfth Street Heritage Development Corporation is requesting a supplement to our current COMBAT contract in the amount of \$12,500. This addition will interface with both our COMBAT neighborhood and community building work and our Re-entry Program. The funding would be used to secure additional administrative assistance and complete our audit.

Twelfth Street's Re-entry Program has received funding of \$25,000 from the City of Kansas City for its Adopt A Lot Program to cut 218 lots between May and September. In addition, we have received a Code Enforcement award for Oak Park Neighborhood in the amount of \$35,000. We currently work with 18-20 ex-offenders, partnering with Connections to Success who assists in identification and screening and the Sanctuary, which assists in preparation and training. We monitor the ex-offenders who are working in our program and supervise them closely.

With our growing community building work, we hope to pilot test a process whereby we can identify a qualified ex-offender to work in our office to prepare expense packets for these and other programs and maintain appropriate program files. For example, these two programs require taking before and after pictures and performing measurements and calculations to ensure that eligible work is being performed. Other work that we can pilot with the selected person will include maintaining attendance and pre- and post-test records that can be used for outcomes reporting.

Thank you for partnering with us to strengthen urban core areas and at-risk populations.

Dear Dr. Daniels-Young,

Thank you for meeting with me to discuss the current backlog of DNA forensic testing that the KCPD Crime Lab is experiencing. This is requiring them to send samples out to other crime labs in an attempt to expedite making results available for investigators. It is typically taking an average of 10 months for these results to be returned to the police. In the interim, offenders arrested with guns may be released "pending further investigation" until the results are returned which may cause the filing of violations of federal firearms laws if the offender is a convicted felon.

The Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission (KCMCC) is the fiscal agent for Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) for the Western District of Missouri. We are currently applying for FY2012-2014 funding that would provide for the lab to employ a forensic DNA examiner to prioritize testing on gun cases which could cause DNA results to be returned in 30-60 days. The amount available for us to apply for does not cover supply needs for the testing. KC Crime Lab Director, Ms. Linda Netzel has a goal to test at least 300 guns per year for the PSN initiative. She reports the following needs that will require funding:

6-DNA Extraction Kits	\$2,172.00
1-DNA Quantification Kit	\$1,550.00
3-DNA Amplification Kits	\$10,245.00
And miscellaneous consumables	<u>\$18,000.00</u> (\$30 per sample tested)
	\$31,967.00

Any amount towards this balance from COMBAT would be needed and appreciated in the interest of public safety.
