5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Mike Sanders, County Executive, said the Royals won the pennant and are going to the World Series. The eyes of the world will be on our fabulous Kauffman and Arrowhead Stadiums. It is a great week in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri.

He discussed the Eastern Jackson County Courthouse project (Ordinance #4680) with Excel Constructors. He said 5 new courtrooms will be added because the most crowded dockets are in eastern Jackson County. He said this would not be possible without the partnership from the courts. We have built trust as well as a cooperative relationship with Judge Marco Roldan and past presiding judges. Mike Sanders thanked Judge Roldan and the 16th Judicial Circuit for allowing us to go forward with this project.

Jackson County Courthouse 415 East 12th Street, 2nd floor Kansas City, Missouri 64106 (816)881-3242 Judge Marco Roldan said the dockets for each judge in Eastern Jackson County run 30-40% higher and renovations at the Eastern Jackson County Courthouse are drastically needed.

Mike Sanders thanked Burns and McDonnell for the great job they did in designing this facility. The exterior tuckpointing was completed last year and the restrooms are in the process of being completed. The completion of this project will be December 2015.

Dennis Waits, County Legislator, gave a special thanks to Shelley Kneuvean, Chief Operating Officer and Stephen Nixon, County Counselor for their work on this project.
