BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute a contract with Cypress Research Associates, for the evaluation, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor, at a cost

to the County not to exceed \$5,000; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreement.

Mental Toughness Group Evaluation Proposal

PROGRAM BACKGROUND

Cypress Research Associates proposes to conduct an evaluation of the Jackson County Drug Court's Mental Toughness Group. The overall goal of the mental toughness group is to encourage successful completion of drug court requirements through team building and counseling (both group and individual counseling). The Mental Toughness Group is designed for people ages 17-24 who are close to being terminated because of one or more of the following reasons:

- Individual is not employed
- Individual has not complied with drug testing requirements OR individual has failed a drug test
- Individual has not attended required counseling sessions.

The Mental Toughness Group is designed for 12-14 people and lasts 10-12 weeks. The first group of participants began the program on September 1st, 2010. Following are components of the program:

- Group counseling (2 times a week)
- Individual counseling
- Class (1 time a week)
- Team building social activities (1 time a week)
- Drug Court team building/accountability exercise in front of their peers (1 time a week)
- Random drug testing

PURPOSE OF RESEARCH & METHODS

An evaluation will be conducted which will include both process and outcome measures of the Mental Toughness Group. Surveys and/or interviews will be conducted with the 12 individuals currently participating in the Mental Toughness Group. Following are initial research questions: (These questions will be expanded upon with the assistance of the program oversight committee).

- ✓ How compliant are participants in completing program requirements?
- ✓ Are participants employed and drug-free?
- ✓ What are the strengths/weaknesses of the team building approach?
- ✓ How effective are the group counseling and individual counseling sessions?
- ✓ What are participants learning from the weekly class?

BUDGET

The total proposed project budget is **\$5,000**. Cypress Research Associates, LLC requests payment of 50% of the budget at the beginning of the project, and the remainder upon project completion.
