WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has solicited formal written bids on Bid No. PW 05-2011 for the Buckner Tarsney Bridge Debris Removal Project, No. 3143; and,

WHEREAS, he has received ten bids thereon, with the three lowest bids as follows:

#### Director Page:

On behalf of the City I would like to thank you for meeting with us on Thursday, August 4<sup>th</sup>. As discussed in that meeting, the City will be partnering with Jackson County Public Works in the clean-up and debris removal at the Buckner Tarsney bridge, located south of Old 40 Highway. As such, I have included a copy of the check that was mailed to the Director of Finance on August 9, 2011. You will see that the total is the mutually agreed amount of \$14,313, which represents half of the project cost (per the low bidder) and half of the cost of the force account.

Additionally, the City would like to reaffirm its position that the sharing of this project is not an acceptance of responsibility for future projects or liability relating to this bridge. As mentioned in the meeting, I would like to see the City and County partner in the future to regularly clean out the bridge, as the multi-cell design is likely to continue collecting debris. Looking ahead, I will commit to share labor and equipment for regularly scheduled bridge maintenance to avoid contracting a clean-up in the future.

In an unrelated matter, the City would like to formally request full a disbursement of CURS funding to complete an overlay project on Duncan Road. The proposed project would begin at the east side of Hedgewood Drive on Duncan Road and continue west for approximately 1,575 LF or until the City's CURS account balance is depleted. The City would ask that the work be performed under the County's current contract with Superior Bowen Asphalt Company.

Again, thank you for meeting with us and I look forward to continued partnership with the County. If you have any questions regarding the bridge clean-up or the proposed CURS project please contact me at 816-847-6200 ext. 400.

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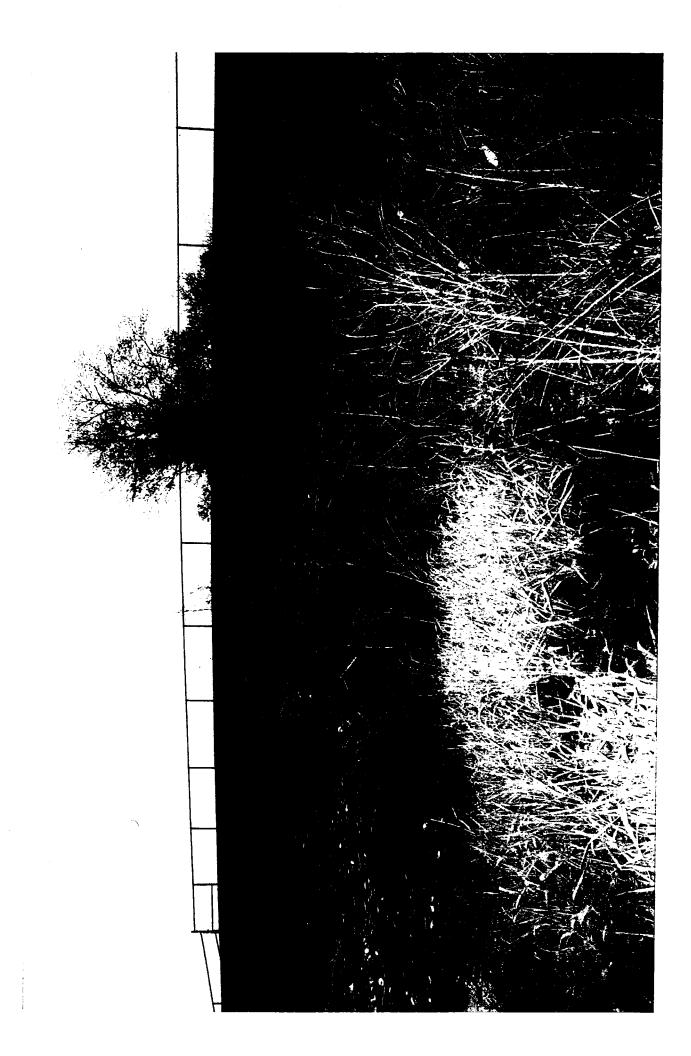
