## 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Mike Sanders, County Executive, said Mr. Spence asked for an opinion from the County Counselor's office on the Pension Board and the liability of particular appointments. It is his understanding that the opinion is done. In the meantime, his office will reappoint all nine members until the issue can be further studied and a task force can be formed. Part of the legal opinion from the County Counselor stated that until the nine members are reappointed by the County Executive they cannot serve in that function on the Pension Board.

The Ethics report is being completed. After the Ethics Task Force presents the report to the County Legislature, it will be put out for public comment on the web site and public hearings will be scheduled.

Theresa A. Garza, County Legislator, asked who to direct her questions regarding the audit (CAFR).

Mike Sanders suggested she talk to Fred Siems, Chief Administrative Officer.

Theresa A. Garza said she was contacted by a constituent who was unable to attend the COMBAT Blue Ribbon Committee meeting and they wanted an email address or contact information so they could ask questions or provide input.

Mike Sanders said they will get the information to her.

James D. Tindall, County Legislator, asked for the names of the nine members of the Pension Board.

Mike Sanders said he will get the names to the County Legislature and prepare an Executive Order for their reappointments.

Theresa A. Garza asked why constituents are unable to click on the Boards and Commission lists on Jackson County's web site and view a brief description of the board or commissions as well as a list of the members.

Mike Sanders said the information has not been created on the web site.

Mike Sanders announced that the COMBAT Task Force will meet on August 9, 2007 at 6 P.M.

Henry C. Rizzo, County Legislator, asked if there are any qualifications for members of the Pension Board.

Mike Sanders said that is one of the legal issues they are reviewing. It was originally drafted that some requirements existed; one from the courts, one from the prosecutor's office etc. regarding their appointees. However, under the Jackson County Charter, only the County Executive can make appointments to Boards and Commissions.
