TITLE: A REOLUTION authorizing the Director of Finance and Purchasing to issue a check in the amount of \$129,119.90 from the 2025 E-911 System Fund for the purchase of 14 portable radios and 6 vehicle radios for use by the Greenwood Police Department.

SUMMARY: WHEREAS the Greenwood Police Department is in need of improving its radio communications systems; and, WHEREAS currently first responders are forced to rely on cell phone devices in areas where the current radio system does not provide adequate coverage, thus imposing significant risks to both first responders and individuals needing emergency relief; and, WHEREAS the Greenwood Police Department has requested assistance in the amount of \$129,119.90 for the purchase of upgraded radio technology with features that will provide enhanced signal quality; and, WHEREAS the City of Greenwood does not have sufficient funds to cover the costs of acquiring this infrastructure; and, WHEREAS funds in the amount of \$129,119.90 is to be issued to the Greenwood Police Department; now therefore, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized to issue a check to the Greenwood Police Department in the amount of \$129,119.90 for
