Project/Title:

Authorize an Agreement with the MID-AMERICA REGIONAL COUNCIL for a LITTLE BLUE RIVER WATERSHED FEASIBILITY STUDY – PHASE ONE.

Request Summary

The US Army Corps of Engineers has proposed a cost-share study be performed to identify mitigation and restoration strategies related to ongoing flooding and degradation happening along the entire length of the Little Blue River and its tributaries. The County owns and manages significant land holdings and improvements in the Little Blue watershed. The Little Blue Trace Trail, the longest trail in Jackson County, has experienced significant damage from severe flooding in recent years.

The cost for the first phase of the study is \$70,000. The Corps has secured a federal grant in the amount of \$25,000 for the study; the remaining funding (\$45,000) is proposed to come from local governments in the watershed participating in the study as stakeholders. The participation level for each stakeholder is generally based on their land area within the watershed. The cost for Jackson County for the first phase of the study is \$9,469. Funding for the project will be allocated to the Corps (\$50,000) and to the Mid America Regional Council (\$20,000). The Corps will be responsible for development of project scope, including preliminary engineering analysis, the project schedule and the long-term project budget in partnership with participating communities. MARC will be responsible for management and facilitation of the project, and will provide technical staff support and their database of relevant natural resource information to support the project's development.

Participation in the first phase of the study does not commit the County, or any other stakeholder, to participate in any future study phase or implementation project. This Agreement, and procurement of services benefiting Jackson County, is supported by Section 1030.2 of the County Code - Purchase from other Government.
