

IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

AN ORDINANCE transferring \$13,377.00 within the 2008 General Fund and \$38,413.00 within the 2008 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund, appropriating \$75,790.00 from the unappropriated surplus of the 2008 Grant Fund, and authorizing the County Executive to extend the Project Safe Neighborhood Grant awarded by the Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission.

ORDINANCE #3979, March 10, 2008

INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission (KCMCC) has awarded a grant to the Prosecuting Attorney's Office in the amount of \$24,000.00, for its Project Safe Neighborhood program, which the County will use to partially fund one full-time prosecutor to assist in the prosecution of federal and/or state criminal charges related to drug-related firearms crimes; and,

WHEREAS, this grant is subject to a local match in the amount of \$51,790.00; and,

WHEREAS, a transfer and appropriation are necessary to place the matching and grant funds in the proper spending accounts; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends said transfer and appropriation; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following transfer and appropriation be and hereby are made:
